I. Beginning a Beautiful Tone With Pizzicato

- Start on Corner of Fingerboard
- Advance to the middle of the fingerboard. TAKE YOUR TIME!
- Pluck with the fleshy part of your finger
- Release the sound.

II. Introducing a Beautiful Tone with the Bow

- The Bow Hold
 - Tip of Thumb and Finger Joint
 - Support The Weight of the Bow with the Left Hand
 - Place each Finger independently.
 - Air Bow Flexibility from the Beginning!
- Placing the Bow
 - Frog, Middle, Upper Part.
- ALL TONE STARTS FROM THE STRING!

III. Bow Division

- The Whole bow is divided into three parts: Lower half, Upper Half Middle.
- Practice pieces at various parts of the bow.
- Work toward a sustained sound for each division of the bow.

IV. Bowing Lanes

- Beginning: Forte, Mezzo Forte, Piano
- Equally beautiful Tone in all lanes

V. BOW WEIGHT

- Medium-Heavy Bow Weight (starting bow weight)
- Heavy Bow Weight (basic weight)
- Light Bow Weight (basic weight)
- Medium-Light Bow Weight (intermediate weight)
- Very-Light Bow Weight- (intermediate weight)
- Very-Heavy Bow Weight- (intermediate weight)

VI. BOW SPEED

- Medium-Slow Bow Speed (starting bow speed)
- Slow Bow Speed (basic bow speed)
- Fast Bow Speed (basic bow speed)
- Medium-Fast Bow Speed (intermediate bow speed)
- Very-Fast Bow Speed (intermediate bow speed)
- Very-Slow Bow Speed (intermediate bow speed)

VII. SUSTAINED LEGATO BOW STROKE

- The basis of most orchestral bow strokes.
- Bow speed, bow length, and bow weight.
- THREE PARTS OF A NOTE: START, DURATION, RELEASE
- ALL ORCHESTRAL STROKES MUST HAVE A BEAUTIFUL TONE FROM THE BEGINNING.

VIII. Using the SUSTAINED LEGATO BOW STROKE with a variety of Articulations.

- ALL STROKES START FROM THE STRING!
- Detache
 - Smooth and connected bow stroke
 - Sustained throughout the stroke
- Staccato
 - Separated sound
 - Start and Release.
- Martele
 - Separate Bows that start with weight. The weight is released as the note starts, and the bow stops at the end of the note
- Spiccato
 - Separate Sound.
 - Starts from the string and lifts of the tone.
