I. General Principles for Determining Solutions

- A. Ability to recognize that a playing problem exists
- B. Ability to dissect problem, e.g. multiple components of spiccato or vibrato skills to help determine <u>how</u> and in <u>what order</u> to fix components of the problem
- C. Need to prioritize solutions when multiple problems occur
 - 1. determine large goals and objectives: which bowing skills, left hand and instrument position skills, and ear training skills first need to be addressed, and in what order
 - 2. priority base solution guidelines: center of body out and large motor motions first, then smaller motions
- D. Need to have multiple solutions to remedy same problem to disguise repetition
